Boonville, Mo. in Howard County

Missouri river mile 196.1

No dams or locks obstruct the channel of the Missouri River from this site to its confluence with the Mississippi River near St. Louis.

CONNECTIVITY

Highway: Direct access to I-70 / U.S. 40, MO 87, and MO 5, approximately 1 ½ hours from Kansas City and 2 ¼ hours from St. Louis.

Rail: Less than 1 mile from Union Pacific Railroad operating in Boonville, Mo. across the Missouri River.

FUTURE PORT DEVELOPMENT

Planning underway to develop a new facility (down river) on an 18-acre parcel east down river of the current site. The master plan includes an access road, dock structure, several storage buildings, truck staging area, and an on-site office building, among other improvements.

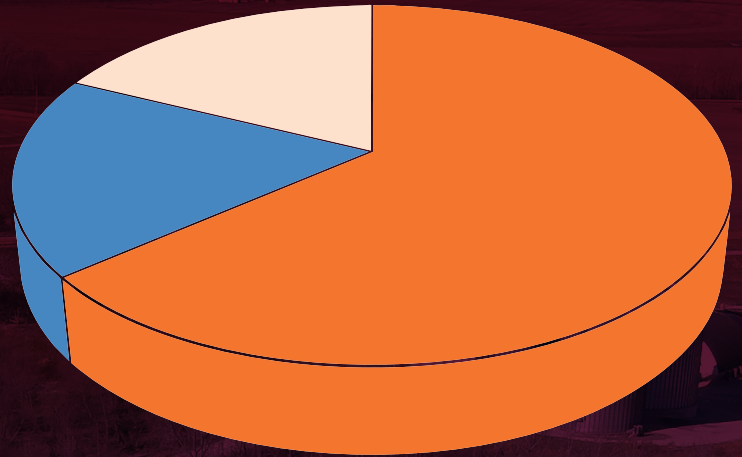
